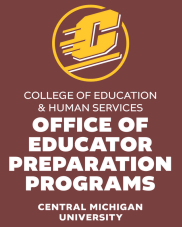

- Students must complete all designated courses above with the required "B" or above standard outlined in the articulation credit agreement
- All students shall meet and maintain Central Michigan University admission requirements
- Student must apply and be admitted to CMU within three (3) years of completing the education program
- Articulated coursework credits will become part of the total number of credits for program completion solely at Central Michigan University and will be listed on the student's Central Michigan University transcript by course code and credit hour(s)
- No tuition and fees will be charged for articulated coursework under this agreement
